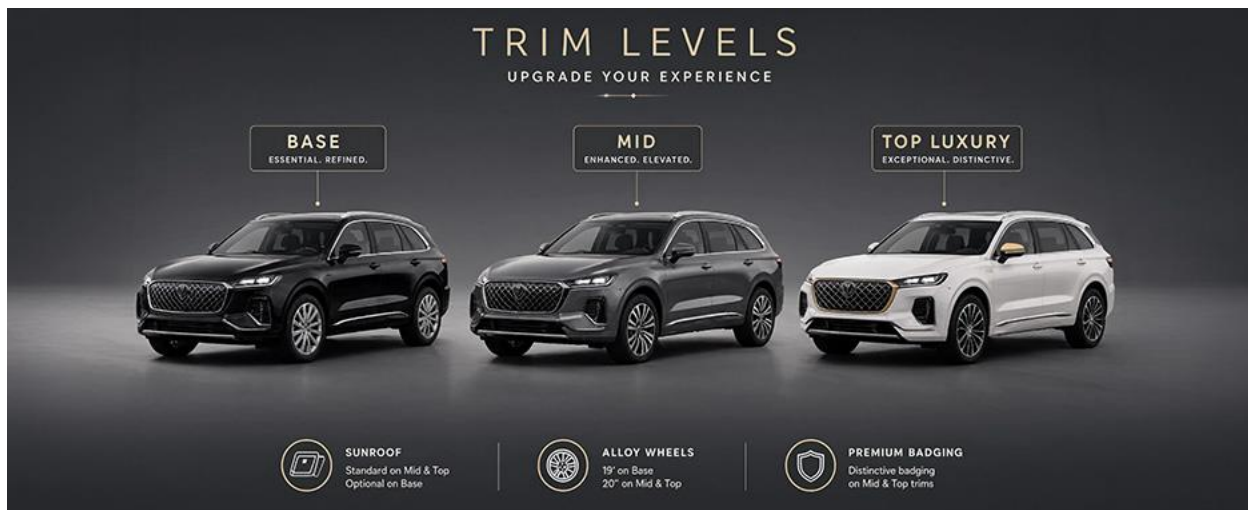


Trim-Level Image Customization: Why It Matters to Buyers

What "Trim Level" Means

Cars don't come in one form only. They usually have several trim lines – from base to luxury, and each of these is different:

- **Features:** The base trim may skip the sunroof or premium audio that the top trim includes
- **Styling:** Badging and wheels can differ noticeably between trims
- **Interior:** Materials and finishes vary even within the same model year

The problem: Many dealer sites still use one stock photo per model, regardless of which trim is actually for sale. Buyers end up viewing a photo that doesn't represent the car they'd be buying.

Why This Hurts Buyers and Dealers

For buyers, an inaccurate photo erodes trust. Research from Cox Automotive shows listings with real, accurate photos generate more leads than those using stock imagery, and mismatched photos are a top shopper frustration. Once trust breaks, buyers start doubting other details too, mileage, condition, price, and move to a competitor's listing instead.

For dealers, the cost is measurable:

- Listings with better-quality, accurate photos meet meaningfully higher lead volume than generic ones
- Misrepresenting a vehicle's features, even unintentionally through a mismatched photo, can also create legal and compliance exposure, not just a lost sale
